2. Scope of the Assignment

Design

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- Develop the information architecture and sitemap;
- Create wireframes or prototypes to visualise the websites' structure and layout;
- Design the user interface (UI) and user experience (UX) elements;
- Choose the colour scheme, typography, and visual elements using RNW Media's brand guidelines;
- Obtain feedback and iterate on the designs.

Development

- Set up the development environment, including the choice of programming languages, frameworks, and content management systems;
- Convert the design into a functional website using HTML, CSS, and JavaScript or a CMS;
- Implement interactive features, such as forms, navigation menus, and search functionality;
- Integrate with databases or other systems;
- Conduct regular testing during the development process.

We are looking for an agency with the following qualifications and skills:

- A good understanding of site tree building and wireframing;
- Relevant experience in interactive (webforms, applications etc.) web UI design;
- Experience in implementing consistent color palettes;
- Ability to provide feedback on current design guidelines and functionality when applicable;
- Strong communication skills, with the ability to communicate detailed concepts clearly and concisely both in writing and verbally;
- Experience in integrating third party tools (CRM, CMS, etc.) via APIs;
- Experience and expertise in HTML, CSS and JavaScript.
